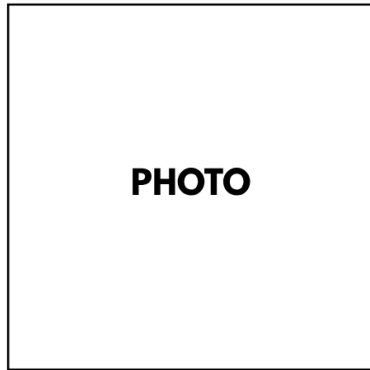

Demonstrates strong and consistent involvement in community education initiatives.	1) Provide structured records such as program schedules and attendance logs that show implementation across multiple cycles rather than one-off events.  <b>Example:</b> - <b>Multi-Phase Implementation Report.</b> - <b>Visual and written documentation across multiple programme series</b>
	B. Leads innovative outreach strategies or educational interventions that effectively address community needs and challenges.	2) Documentation of your role as a founder or leader, including original program proposals or concept papers authored by you.  <b>Example:</b> - <b>Program Proposal/Concept Paper.</b>
	C. Contributes significantly to community education at institutional, local, and broader levels, demonstrating influence and reach beyond immediate contexts.	3) Evidence of formal collaborations (MoU/MoA) with NGOs or government agencies showing implementation at local, district, or national levels.  <b>Example:</b> <b>Cross-Site Impact Portfolio demonstrating implementation in diverse communities or regions.</b>

	A. Demonstrates clear and tangible outcomes in the community.	1) Measurable Achievement (KPIs): Comprehensive reports that integrate quantitative data (percentages, counts) and qualitative data to show clearly defined outcomes.  <b>Example:</b> - <b>Comprehensive Impact Report.</b>
	B. Ensures initiatives create lasting benefits beyond short-term activities.	2) Sustainability Mechanisms: Evidence of "train-the-trainer" models or community-led continuations that function without your direct involvement.  <b>Example:</b> - <b>Sustainability &amp; Capacity Transfer Record.</b>
	C. Serves as a role model or reference for others in community education.	3) Proof that your framework or educational model has been adopted or adapted by other institutions or cited in official reports.  <b>Example:</b> - <b>Model Adaptation Evidence/Citations</b>

	C. Shows sustained dedication to community engagement activities.	3) A timeline showing consistent, voluntary participation in community activities over several years, beyond your mandated professional roles.  <b>Example:</b> <b>Multi-Year Engagement Timeline.</b>
